

# COLLEGE OF EDUCATION COACHING ENDORSEMENT

The Coaching Endorsement is open to students in the University that plan to coach at the High School or Community level after graduation. The Kansas State High School Activities Association (KSHSAA) has accepted the K-State College of Education Coaching Endorsement as a substitute or waiver of the American Coaching Effectiveness Program (ACEP), which is currently being offered through the KSHSAA educational program.

Any KSU student interested in the College of Education Coaching Endorsement program should take the following ten (10) hours of course work:

EDSEC 250 Scientific Principles of Coaching .....	3 hrs
HN 320 Care and Prevention of Athletic Injuries .....	3 hrs
EDSEC 587 Supervised Practicum for Coaches .....	2 hrs
One "Coaching & Officiating" Class .....	2 hrs
(examples: Class offered on a rotational basis)	
Coaching & Officiating Basketball, Football, Volleyball, Track, Baseball and Soccer.	
.....	10 Hrs. Total

\* Note: EDSEC587 Practicum/Athletic Coaching (2 hrs. Credit/No Credit) meets by appointment. The class does not meet on a regular basis; the classroom time consists of coaching a sports team. Course requirements are: 1) Help coach a sports team from a High School Middle School, or Community Recreation Program.

- 2) Keep a weekly log of activities which will be submitted to:  
Mary Lou Morgan upon completion of your coaching assignment.
- 3) Have your immediate supervisor complete the attached Coaching Practicum Form at the completion of the sports Season

Early in your graduation semester, please inform the Department of Secondary Education office that you have completed the courses required for the Coaching Endorsement. A personalized certificate will be made, and the endorsement recorded on your KSU transcript.

# COACHING PRACTICUM

## EDSEC 587 (2 cr.)

The coaching practicum (EDSEC 587) provides individual pursuing a coaching endorsement with an opportunity to gain experience (and course credit) in coaching a specific sport over the course of a season. There are several options for obtaining course credit:

- Assist with a varsity/junior varsity athletic team. The Department of Secondary Education partners with Manhattan High School to provide opportunities to work with experienced coaches in a variety of sports. Individual interest in, this option should contact Mary Lou Morgan (785-776-6029) in advance of the semester you wish to enroll in EDSEC 587.
- Coach! assist with a youth sports team. Manhattan Parks and Recreation collaborates with the Department of Secondary Education to provide opportunities to coach/assist with a variety of youth sports. Individuals interested in this option should contact Mike Buchanan at Manhattan Parks and Recreation (785-587-2757).
- Coach/assist with a summer sports camp/program. Check with Mary Lou Morgan concerning your participation and eligibility to receive credit for EDSEC 587.
- Assist with a varsity/junior varsity team during the student teaching semester. EDSEC 587 can be taken concurrently with EDSEC 586 (student teaching). Check with Dr. Scharmann, Chair, Department of Secondary Education (785-532-5904). concerning your participation and eligibility to receive credit for EDSEC 587.

*Note: To obtain final credit fore the EDSEC 587 experience, each student coach is asked to submit a weekly log of their work responsibilities and have their coaching supervisor fill out the "coaching Practicum Evaluation Form".
