### Scholarship Types and Award Criteria

**Private Scholarships:** Criteria vary by scholarship. The scholarships are established by donors through endowments and/or expendable funds.

**Premier Scholarships:** University scholarships awarded to incoming freshmen based on ACT scores, GPA, high school class standing, etc.. Scholarship recipients are guaranteed four years of award dependent on maintaining  $\geq$  3.5 GPA. These scholarships are funded by the University General Scholarship account the first year and maintained by the student's respective college the following years.

- College maintains: Presidential, Putnam, and Foundation Scholarships.
- University maintains: Honors, Transfer Honors, Purple and White, Legacy, and Denison; Freshmen only awards- Leadership, Medallion, Achievement, Fairchild, Activity, First in Class, Minority, Community College Transfer, Salina, Kassebaum, Civic Leadership, and Opportunity Scholarships.
